THE EFFECTS OF TAXATION

With the increase of government activities, mainly during the 20th century, the ratio of tax revenues (including social security contributions) to GDP has risen to around 40 percent in European countries. Such a high level of taxation can be expected to significantly influence the behavior of private households as well as firms. Knowledge of the effects of taxes represents an indispensable prerequisite for the design of an efficient and equitable tax system.
